



Yachtmaster® Sail Fast Track Modules



If you would like to become a professional Yachtmaster and have done no sailing, a little or quite a bit – this is the course for you. Using a modular approach you can do one module at a time or all of them together – slotting in at the appropriate level for you.

We split our fast track into two 4 week modules and one 5 week module for two reasons: often people can not take 13 weeks of at once; and sometimes they join us with previous experience:

- Module 1: Competent Crew to Day Skipper (Tidal) (4 weeks, covering approx. 600 miles)
- Module 2: Day Skipper (Tidal) to Coastal Skipper (Tidal) (4 weeks, covering approx. 1100 miles)
- Module 3: Coastal Skipper (Tidal) to Yachtmaster MCA (5 weeks, covering approx. 1200 miles)
- Module 4: Convert your Yachtmaster into Cruising Instructor so you can teach (3 weeks)

If you join us for Modules 1 through 3 you gain 2500 miles required for your YM exam, together with 5 qualifying passages. We also include VHF (SRC), First Aid, Sea Survival and a Diesel Engine course as well as your Powerboat Level 2 and your Sea Survival.

We start the modules every four weeks so are sure to find a month to start which will suit you.

If you do join us direct for modules 2 or 3 we will also offer you the option to increase your existing mileage with an extra milebuilding week, or two, so that you can gain the required 2500 miles you need for Yachtmaster. With this option we include a one day course with each module (First Aid, Diesel Engine or VHF (SRC)).

The Cruising Instructor Module is run on demand, and may be able to offer you a contract to work for us at the end should this interest you.

During your time with us you will gain experience of both our Classic (Bavaria 36), and our Club Class (Hanse 400e, Prima 38 and Sun Odyssey 39i, 42i and 45DS) – giving you experience of different types of boats. We also often use a Nauticat 521 for milebuilding.

Included in your modules:

- Transfers from Tenerife South airport – no additional costs or waiting for a taxi;
- Because of our location you have the advantage that you normally arrive in our marina within 20 minutes of collecting your bags;
- Accommodation throughout the modules is included;
- All our clients get their own cabin – no need to share;
- Freshly laundered sheets, duvets and towels – no sleeping bags with liners or any need to bring your own;
- 6 days of tuition per week from an experienced Instructor – we do not use instructors who have just qualified;

- Theory tuition in our purpose built air conditioned classroom a couple of minutes walk from the marina;
- All the charts and handouts for your theory course, as well as the loan of a plotter and dividers;
- Sailing courses on our range of yachts – all with different rigs;
- Light weight waterproofs – just in case;
- Food and drink on board – including a gin and tonic or a beer after a days sailing, breakfast and lunch every day as well as 2 evening meals per week (more when milebuilding);
- All mooring fees, diesel and gas – no hidden extras;
- The chance to explore the beautiful and unspoilt areas of Tenerife, La Gomera, La Palma and Gran Canaria - as well as islands further afield.

We do not include: flights, travel insurance or evening meals ashore, but are happy to offer you ideas and recommendations.
